Energy consumer rights protection

Annotation.

The study discipline "Energy consumer rights protection" belongs to the list of the study disciplines of the Ph.D candidate's free choice. This module aims to provide the students, based on the comparative analysis of the international experience of energy consumer rights protection in different countries, with the knowledge of the theoretical and practical issues of energy policy, energy security in terms of human rights concept, the approaches to understanding of the access to modern energy services as a human right and its national and international regulation, the role of national regulatory authorities in energy consumer rights protection, the mechanisms of energy consumer rights protection etc.

General number of credits: 4.

Lecturer: Vashchenko Y.V., doctor of legal sciences, professor of the administrative law department, director of the Educational and research center of human rights and governanace.

The aim of the study discipline: to develop the understanding of the peculiarities of energy consumer rights: to encourage the understanding the peculiarities of the realization and protection of the energy consumer rights at international and national levels.

Entrance requirements: the Ph.D candidate shall know: the main concepts of Human Rights theory, in particular, the notion of human rights, generations of human rights, international protection of human rights, violations against human rights. Ph.D candidate shall have necessary knowledge of the theory of law and the main branches of law, understand the topical issues on human rights protection.

The main topics: energy policy, energy security and energy law in terms of human rights concept; a right to access to modern energy services as a human right: international and national dimensions: energy regulation and energy consumer rights protection.

Language of instructions: English

Place in the structurally-logical scheme: ДВА 3.02.16 (taught during the second year of studies).

Period of studies: the study discipline is taught on the second year of studies of the educational and research level "doctor of philosophy", with 120 hours, including 24 contact hours (18 hours – lectures, 4 hours – seminars, 2 hours – consultations), 96 hours of independent work.
